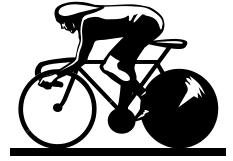

Bois Forte Band of Chippewa (Nett Lake)	Vermilion Trail Extension: This project is seeking funds to extend the existing pedestrian/bike trail to Highway 77 and beyond.	\$170,000	\$236,000	Bike/Ped Trail
